- Emergency Management (GPREP) A practice session for the electronic registration system (RRCP) is being planned.
- Fire Department The fire crews are currently completing their annual pump operator training, working from hydrants, and drafting from portable water tanks.
- RCMP GP RCMP Detachment is excited to announce the launch of a community engagement project focusing on increased visibility in GP's parks, trail systems, and in the downtown core of the City. RCMP officers will patrol throughout the parks and trail system while using a utility terrain vehicle (UTV) and engage with members of the public.
