- Community Social Development - The Youth Advisory Council is working with Communications and Marketing on their summer/fall recruitment campaign. The Youth Advisory Council provided input on appropriate cultural supports for supportive housing projects. Seniors Week is June 7-13; Home Support Workers delivered self-care bags to clients to recognize them.

- Enforcement Services - As of June 3, there are 4 full time officers are assigned to bike patrols. Media interviews were conducted last week as there is an interest in the APIS ticketing project.
- Emergency Management (GPREP) - A practice session for the electronic registration system (RRCP) is being planned.
- Fire Department - The fire crews are currently completing their annual pump operator training, working from hydrants, and drafting from portable water tanks.
- RCMP - GP RCMP Detachment is excited to announce the launch of a community engagement project focusing on increased visibility in GP's parks, trail systems, and in the downtown core of the City. RCMP officers will patrol throughout the parks and trail system while using a utility terrain vehicle (UTV) and engage with members of the public.




