














Relocation Benefits

The relocation to Centre 2000 will...

- increase Archives space by 5,631 square feet
- address the Archives' long term space requirements
- provide a secure, dedicated space for archival research
- enhance collection care, security, and professionalism
- increase capacity to host programs and offer services
- eliminate the flood risk posed by Muskoseepi Reservoir
- compliment existing tourism and visitor services
- leverage municipal investments to access grants

The preliminary cost estimate presented is for budgetary purposes only, based on per square foot building construction methodology. The service rooms and existing washrooms were assumed to not require any renovations and were not included in the area calculations.

Items factored into the construction budget estimate include: Interior walls, doors, and windows to suit proposed layout; Millwork including reception counters, work counters, and staff kitchen; Flooring; Ceilings; New LED light fixtures throughout renovated spaces; Modifications to electrical to suit new rooms and equipment; Modifications to HVAC to suit new rooms; Modifications to plumbing for new kitchen and barrier-free washroom; Modifications to sprinkler system and fire alarm system to suit new rooms and layout; Professional fees include architectural and engineering costs associated with the design and construction.
