

Notice of Intention to Designate the Grande Prairie Courthouse (1957) as a Municipal Historic Resource

HISTORICAL RESOURCES ACT
R.S.A. 2000, cH.-9, as amended, Section 26

Notice is hereby given that sixty (60) days from the date of service of this Notice, the Municipal Council of the City of Grande Prairie intends to pass a Bylaw that the structure known as the Grande Prairie Courthouse (1957) and the land on which such structure is located, legally described as:

PLAN 1246CL

BLOCK 2

Lot A

(Formerly Plan 1410AC, Block 7, Lots 7 & 8, James H. Smith survey, 1910)

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

And municipally described as the Centre for Creative Arts, 9904 101 Ave. Grande Prairie Alberta T8V 0X8, be designated a MUNICIPAL HISTORIC RESOURCE under Section 26 of the *Historical Resources Act*, as amended from time to time.

This notice of intention protects this historic resource from alteration, demolition, and disturbance for 120 days from the date of announcement, however, City Council gives approval for the Corporate Facilities Department to continue with preventative maintenance, operational repairs, renewal, and capital projects.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the Municipal Council of the City of Grande Prairie has appointed the Manager of Sports Development, Wellness & Culture department to implement matters arising from the issuance of the Notice of Intention to Designate a Municipal Historic Resource.
