#### 4.1 <u>Service Area Update</u>

P. Bailey, Chief Strategy Officer, presented Committee with an update on the current and projected activities planned throughout the service area:

- Community Connections The total responses for Budget Engagement is 900, of which 500 were in person and 400 online; an update will be provided in the coming weeks to share the key insights and takeaways. The Special Olympics Alberta Summer Games are set to begin this Friday, with the opening ceremonies at Bonnetts Energy Centre; AccessGP is extending 311 Contact Centre services from Friday to Sunday to ensure athletes, families, and visitors get quick and accurate information during the event.
- Invest Grande Prairie Registration is now closed for the Asclepius Medical Camp, a program for high school students run by University of Alberta medical student volunteers. The camp received 108 applications for 50 spots and offer letters have been sent. Administration recently met with two physicians: one who has just relocated with their family to begin work at the Grande Prairie Regional Hospital, and another who is expected to arrive in early September.
- Legislative & Executive Services The second Candidate Information Session on August 20 will focus on municipal finance; registration is required. The election worker recruitment campaign for the 2025 Municipal and School Board Trustee election has now launched; information is available on the city's website. These are paid positions with multiple shift options available.
